City Managers Report:

- Terry's Towing Update
Plan has been submitted and City Planner has red lined the plan and will return for modification. Manager Andrew presented the council with a list of concerns pertaining to the plan submitted
- 5509 Lease Agreement
Manager Andrew advised that Attorney Proctor countered the lease agreement offered to him and stated that the improvements that he is intending on completing cost approximately \$10,000 and suggested \$275.00 off each month for 18 months to cover the costs of just the floor.

After some discussion there was a motion made to offer a lease agreement to Mr. Proctor that stipulated a decrease in rent by \$175.00 a month over three (3) years for a total of \$6,300.00 worth of credit for improvements to the leased spaced that the tenant will provide. The items to be completed within twelve (12) months are flooring installed, walls and cabinets installed as well as the needed plumbing installed. It was further noted that the rent would increase annually and a security deposit of \$800.00 would be required.
