## **STANDARDS OF WORK PERFORMED**

All work on City of Flowery Branch road projects must be performed in accordance with provisions and requirements set forth by the Georgia Department of Transportation.

## **TRAFFIC CONTROL**

The contractor shall provide traffic control to include all items necessary to maintain safe travel for the public. Traffic control shall include, but is not limited to: road closed signs, barricades, detour signs, flagging, work zone signs, low/soft shoulder signs, etc. All traffic control devices and work zones shall comply with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), latest edition. Throughout the length of the project, all traffic control items shall be maintained by the Contractor.

The Contractor shall install all required striping as quickly as possible, but no later than 3 days after the road is completed unless directed otherwise by the project manager.

Measurements and descriptions are approximate only. Actual quantities for pay items will be derived by field measurements and weight measurements.

The Contractor is to field verify the widths of all roads. Resurfacing shall be over existing asphalt only.

## **SCHEDULE**

In order to plan accordingly, please note: The bid will be awarded at the City Council Meeting on February 7, 2019 at 6:00 PM. The Contractor is required to complete this contract by **May 31, 2019**. Time extensions may be given if the anticipated award date of the contract is delayed or unusual number of inclement weather days occurs during the contract period.
